Detailed instructions for the Spinner Skirt, one way design skirt and the Zig Zag skirt

Tag board wedge. Note: Your wedge will be cut at the skirt length you put on your registration form. Facilities fees.

Fabric Kit Cost: \$65 Kit includes enough fabric to make up to a 23" long skirt 2.5 yards Red, .75 yard White, 1.5 yards Black 1.5" elastic to your size

Space is limited. Register early.

Note: This skirt is best done using a serger. We will have a few sergers available the day of the class if for some reason you cannot bring your own. We will not be giving serger lessons.
