How Do You Make a Convention?

If you attend the Wisconsin Convention in Appleton this August, you will experience about 25 hours of dancing with a dizzying carousel of callers and cuers rotating in and out of various halls. There will be teaching seminars at many levels of square and round dancing, as well as demonstrations, vendors, educational seminars and programs, including a fashion show. Housing and camping options have been researched and reserved for you.

You, as a dancer, just see the finished product—a (mostly) seamless three-days of fun and entertainment. What you don't see are the hours and hours of work done by the convention board and general chairman to make sure the basic elements (space, dancing, teaching, exhibitions, displays, vendors, style show, lodging, registration, and food) all happen without a hitch.

Sometimes this means hours of meetings with local officials to get permission for camping or parking. The general chairmen and their team gathers to discuss themes, plan publicity, share information about various committee work, and to practice the skit performed at the current convention to advertise the next convention.

So for every hour of the convention you enjoy, know that at least 25 hours of time has been volunteered to make it happen.

The state convention is a gem—enjoy every minute.
