Step on the beat of the music.

Though we are much different than your average dancing we still strive to take one step on each downbeat of the music. Calls have a specific "timing". That means there is "x" number of beats/steps to complete a call. If you take one step per beat you will find that you will have an easier time in accomplishing each call. Refrain from skipping or otherwise rushing the call.

Keeping the square smaller

It's easy for a square to get out of control. If you step on the beat of the music and don't take long, lunging steps, you will automatically keep your square smaller but there are other things that are helpful. When promenading home the men should "spiral" inward so that their elbows are almost touching.

This is a great help to the ladies - those that have the shorter legs and are trying to cover more distance.

Breathe with the square.....

When Heads Promenade or any movement where two couples have to travel around the outside, the other two couples should move in so that the outside couples do not have as far to travel. Just be sure to "breathe out" if that couple has to come into the center of the square.

Smile, laugh at yourself, help others, and just have fun!
