How angels behave and treat the new dancers, other angels, and visitors will affect class members' decisions whether or not to join our club. They are role models and no matter what the instructor and club try to communicate to the students concerning etiquette, attitudes, or styling, class members inevitably take their cues from what they see the angels doing.

Some tips: **ANGELS ARE NOT TEACHERS** The primary **teaching** function of an angel is to teach by example. To be in the right place at the right time. One important thing you can do is to establish handholds after every move. It is always tempting to explain something your square is not getting and the students will often ask you to do this -- **BUT YOU MUST RESIST**. It diverts the student's attention from the teacher and one of the most important things to learn in beginner class is to listen to the teacher/caller.

Encourage students. Never embarrass someone by saying "Phil isn't getting this." It is better to let the square break down so the instructor can see where help is needed than to do too much pushing and pulling.

The new dancers must learn the calls with standard styling, that is, without the flourishes we like so much. Lead by example and do the calls just the way they are taught, and later the dancers can learn your club styling.

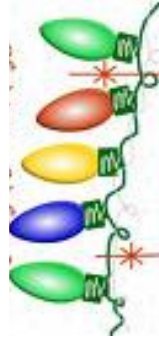
